There are lots of great jazz books available these days. Composers such as Uri An Rovner, Bradley Sowash, Lee Evans, and Bill Boyd all have good collections available at all levels. You could consider having your students play down a level or two for quicker and more secure playing. This will be a FUN, creative event!! We do need a copy of each student's music so that our ensemble players can look it over prior to the big day. And please, write in chord symbols. They needn't be complicated! Notating 9ths, 13ths, or augmented 5ths is NOT necessary. Our bass player just needs a bass line to read. MEMORY is OPTIONAL! Since this Festival is a prototype, memory is not required. We want *all students* to participate and since they're working with other musicians on stage, having the music in front of them may help certain students this first time around. We really are looking forward to this event and excited to be offering something new and creative. Help us make it a success!
