- 1. Go to www.mtnacertification.org (the page is a forest green color)
- 2. Left side menu list, under MTNA, click on Renewal
- 3. Left side menu: Procedure Requirements Activities Fees Right side menu: list of renewal documents + link for online renewal

I recommend you print the Renewal Application Form. Read through the activities you must do to get points for renewal. Find activities you have done or are currently doing and mark them. (I keep a pile of programs where I, or students have performed.) A few times during the year, update your ongoing Renewal form so when the anxious moment arrives to send it in (online or 'snail'), you will be ready. Contact me with questions.
