The minutes from the January meeting were approved.

Gary Bishop, Treasurer, corrected an error on the agenda. The checking account balance should read \$1,111.46, not \$111.46; Scholarship Savings CD, \$5,814.48. The financial review committee, Kathryn Hammer and Arlyce Black, recommended closing the Scholarship Certificate of Deposit, \$1,467.05, and adding it to the Scholarship Savings Account. The current interest rate does not warrant keeping these funds in a separate account. This has been done.

Barnes & Noble has given FMTA \$3,500 for our weekend of recitals at the Denver West B&N.

LaVon Cooper, Scholarship Chair, announced scholarships which were awarded May 2013, have been sent to Jonathan Riley, \$1,000 and Rachel Artley, \$500. Scholarships are not given until the end of the first semester of college.

In preparation for writing comments for Achievement Day, *The Four Elements of a Great Critique*, by Marcia Vahl was discussed. Copies were made available.

Motion: that to reduce expenses for the Sonatina Festival, only two winners/trophies per section will be awarded. **Motion Approved.**
