Deadline for the FMTA 2015 Sonatina Festival Entries is March 11, 2015 by 9p.m. Why not send yours in early this year? The event is Saturday, April 11, 2015 and winners Recitals are the same day at Colorado Christian University. We plan to have a 5:00 & a 6:00 recital. Send entries, one check payable to FMTA and postage paid return self-addressed envelope by deadline date or before to: Linda Pott, FMTA Sonatina Chair, 6042 Field Street, Arvada, CO. Please read the standing rules posted on the website to make sure you and your students understand the rules, as they have been updated. All students need to have a legal copy (not a photocopy) of their music, with every measure numbered.

To have the event run smoothly, all teachers are expected to work the day of the festival. If you have a special scheduling need for yourself that day, let us know and we will try to have you work per your request. **Absolutely no student scheduling requests can be honored.** We hope to notify teachers of winning students on the website this year.
