ANNOUNCING A NEW SONATINA EVENT FOR ADULTS

There were so many adult students performing in the Ensemble Event in October that a motion was passed at the November meeting to give them another opportunity to perform via their own Sonatina Festival. For this event an "adult" is considered to be anyone having graduated from high school. All adult students of FMTA members are encouraged to participate in this non-competitive and non-rated event. Written evaluations will be given and students may perform on any instrument, including guitar and voice. Participants will follow the rules for the FMTA Sonatina Festival, with the exception being pianists may ignore the required list and may perform any sonatina/sonata of their choice and memorization is not required for any instrument. Instruments other than piano will perform two contrasting selections using the guidelines in the Standing Rules. Students will perform in a recital setting but it may be possible to request a private audition. We are planning this event for the afternoon of March 12th.
