If this is not possible, it is your responsibility to find someone to cover your work assignment, and inform the chairman with contact information. This is a one day festival, with recitals in the late afternoon/evening.

CSMTA has made changes in the Student Theory Assessment (STA) program in which students are stimulated and recognized for their theory competency. The testing offered by the California Merit Program is no longer available. Instead the Keynote Independent Theory Service (KITS), which offers tests in Reading, Vocabulary, Listening, and Skills Performance will now be used.
