## 20 OPTIONS

1. Additional piece, memorized or not memorized (may be chosen 3 times)
2. Scales (see level chart in CSMTA Students Activities Handbook)
3. Chords (see level chart)
4. Arpeggios (see level chart)
5. Sight reading (at two levels below entered level)
6. Improvisation
7. Play from a lead line adding accompaniment – bring own music
8. Collaborative performance, (accompanying, duet, etc.)
9. Performance on a second instrument
10. Transposition – bring own music
11. Dance
12. Conducting (see levels in email)
13. Written theory test
14. Terms and signs test
15. Music history test
16. Written ear training test
17. Original composition (written by hand or computer) performed in hospitality room
18. Written project: composers, music history, scrapbook, analysis, etc.
19. Construction project – mobiles, game, something “built” related to music
20. Art related to music – picture, poster, drawing, collage, etc.
