

## "Continuing Education Opportunities"

How do we continue our education after we've left the Music Halls of Higher Education? We read articles in music journals – we join local associations and attend programs geared to our interests – we attend live music performances - AND we attend our state and national music conferences.

Our Music Teachers National Association Conference, March 26 – 30, 2022, is giving us the opportunity to pay an early register fee by March 15<sup>th</sup>. By attending this virtual conference, you have until December 15<sup>th</sup> to view any sessions which are of interest to you. With this virtual format you save the cost of attending in person, which can be almost \$2,000. When you attend in person – which everyone should try do as often as possible – you have to make choices of which sessions you want to attend at which hour, for there are often 5-6 sessions offered every hour. This year you only need to choose which session to watch first as you will have access to view sessions for more than eight months after paying the early registration fee.

The Colorado State Music Teachers Association Conference scheduled for June 3-4, 2022 in Boulder, is only a two day event with the usual Local Association Luncheon being an evening meal this year on Saturday, June 4th. To gain the most from this conference, plan to treat yourself and stay overnight on Friday with a roommate.

Attending the MTNA and CSMTA Conferences is a privilege of our membership in these associations and is an opportunity to continue growing musically. You can't afford to not attend each of these events. See you there!

### Sonatina Festival: March 12, 2022

The 2022 edition of FMTA's Sonatina Festival takes place Saturday, March 12. As usual, before COVID times, our venue is Colorado Christian University Music Center, 9200 W. Ellsworth, Lakewood, CO. Parking is available nearby. The 2022 Festival has 28 teachers, including our five judges, and 119 students participating this year. All workers are asked to bring their own snacks. Water will be provided.

In accordance with the guidelines of Jefferson County and Colorado Christian University, masks are not required. However, masks are optional this year.

Teachers and students should notice the schedule in the lobby and check in at the registration desk. At 7:45, 1<sup>st</sup> shift monitors will meet with judges. Adjudication begins at 8:10 and concludes by 2:00.

**Results are in by 2:45. Honors Recital times are 4:00 and 5:00.** Throughout the day, winners are posted at <u>www.fmtamusic.org</u>. Check the online list periodically as it will be updated throughout the day. Teachers will notify their student winners of recital times asking students and their families and friends to arrive on time for honors recitals.

Students report to their performance location 10 minutes early. Students must provide their original score, measures numbered, for their judge. Regarding several students performing for comments only and using music, a copy of their music must be provided for their judge. In the rare occasion space allows, the room monitor may admit listeners.
